Dear Central Ohio ASME members,

In a newsletter at the beginning of this season, I told you I am Dutch. In soccer terms, that means I am an *International*. Realizing this made me wonder how many members of ASME International actually live outside North America. When I investigated this a little further, Michael Michaud, ASME Director of International Operations supplied me with some very interesting statistics.

Michaud explained that ASME maintains a separate geographic region (Region XIII) for members outside the U.S., Canada, and Mexico. Region XIII has 18 sections, representing approximately 10% of all ASME International members! That means that more than 10,000 ASME members live outside North America! In fact, these members live in 141 different countries!

The top ranked Technical Divisions in Region XIII are (first choice - in order):

Management	11.8%
Applied Mechanics	8.2%
Design	7.3%
Pressure Vessels and Piping	6.0%
International Gas Turbine Institute	5.9%
Heat Transfer	5.6%
Fluids Engineering	5.4%

For those of you who have been to ASME conferences, it is remarkable how many speakers and presenters come from foreign destinations. ASME opens the doors and provides a medium for people from all engineering professions and all engineering specialties to present and publish their research results. ASME International also has Agreements of Cooperation with 58 Engineering Societies in other countries. Overseas customers account for approximately 35% of Codes and Standards sales.

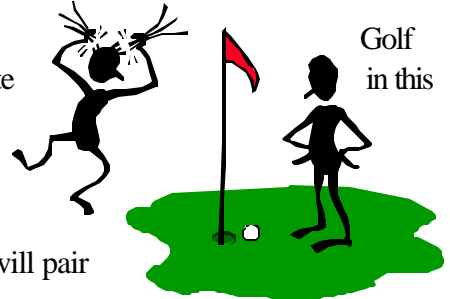

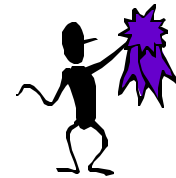


